The Company accomplishes this by leveraging decades of medical industry relationships, an 80,000-square-foot state-of-the-art distribution center with inbound and outbound loading docks, locations for thousands of pallets, extensive material handling equipment, and attention to detail driven by its ISO9001:2015 certification.
